Answer:

- 1.) **authentic** – If something is authentic, it is real, true or what people say it is.
- 2.) **smudged** – cause (something) to become messily smeared by rubbing it.
- 3.) **intuitive** – using or based on what one feels to be true even without conscious reasoning; instinctive.
- 4.) **acquitted** – to decide officially in a law court that someone is not guilty of a particular crime.
- 5.) **gratify** – to please someone, or to satisfy a wish or need.
- 6.) **visualize** – to form a picture of someone or something in your mind, in order to imagine or remember him, her, or it.
- 7.) **accomplish** – to finish something successfully or to achieve something.
- 8.) **perspective** – a particular way of considering something.
- 9.) **divergent** – different or becoming different from something else.
- 10.) **conventional** – traditional or ordinary.
- 11.) **elegant** – graceful and attractive in appearance or behavior.
- 12.) **suspicious** – having or showing a cautious distrust of someone or something.
- 13.) **ferocious** – frightening and violent.
- 14.) **hiatus** – a short pause in which nothing happens or is said, or a space where something is missing.
- 15.) **hindsight** – the ability to understand an event or situation only after it has happened.
