Later he formed Azad Hind Fauj or Indian National Army and continued his fight for the freedom of India. He was a man with exceptional patriotic zeal. However, it is supposed that this legendary leader died on 18th August, 1945 in a plane crash. In the history of freedom struggle of India, there is no one who could replace Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose in popularity and respect.
