


Question: Read the passage carefully and answer the following questions:

Mohan and Solar System

Mohan was a boy of eight years. When he was coming back from school, he heard his friend use the word solar system. Mohan had never heard this word before and



wanted to learn about it. He went home and asked his parents

about it. His parents sat with him and explained what the new word meant. His father told him that the solar system is a collection of the Sun, eight planets



revolving around the Sun and their moons along with countless asteroids, comets, etc. His father also told him that the Sun is the largest star of the Solar system. Mohan's mother told him that there are eight planets in the solar system and that these planets revolve around the Sun. The planets from closest to the furthest from the Sun are Mercury (smallest planet), Venus (the morning star), Earth (blue planet), Mars (red planet), Jupiter (largest planet), Saturn(the ringed planet), Uranus and Neptune (ice giant). He also learned that there used to be a ninth planet named Pluto, which in 2006 was renamed as a



dwarf planet by scientists. Mohan was excited after learning so much about the solar system and wanted to visit the local science exhibition the next day.
